There is *no power*, so teams must bring a propane type cooking stove (Coleman Burner) and a large pot to cook with as well a cooking thermometer and cooking safety materials.\*\*

We will have entertainment and plenty of activities for the kids. Admission price includes chili, hot dogs, and beverages (water, sodas, beer).
